Dale became interested in magic after seeing a Black Stone episode on TV. Santa brought him a magic kit that Christmas and he was off and running. Dale now performs magic as part of his stage show, but in addition to that he also uses magic to teach safety to children, and has performed for the troops returning from Iraq. Dale has also performed at several Texas venues including the Wylie Opry, River Oaks Texas Opry, and the Texas Country Music Hall Of Fame Showcase where he went to the finals.
